Homemade Model Magic Recipe

This recipe offers a variation from the commercial version, providing a texture that's not crumbly like typical homemade playdough. In fact, it boasts a lighter, softer feel that's a pleasure to work with.

You'll Need:

• A saucepan

Ingredients:

- 2 cups of baking soda
- 1 cup of cornstarch
- 1 1/2 cups of water
- Food coloring

Instructions:

- 1. In a large saucepan, combine the baking soda, cornstarch, and water.
- 2. Place the saucepan on medium heat and stir constantly. As you do, you'll notice the mixture gradually forming a ball of dough.
- 3. Allow the mixture to cool for a few minutes.
- 4. Next, divide the mixture into smaller sections, forming individual balls.
- 5. Take one of the dough balls and create a small hole in it. Add a bit of food coloring into the hole.
- 6. Knead the dough ball thoroughly to ensure the food coloring is evenly distributed. If you want a more vibrant hue, add more food coloring and knead again. Repeat this process with each dough ball.
- 7. To store your homemade model magic, place it in airtight containers. Remember to use it within 24 hours for the best results.
