How to Play Mingle Icebreaker

- 5. Exclusion Clause: There's a catch, though: those left without a group of the exact number are momentarily sidelined. This twist introduces an element of anticipation and camaraderie.
- 6. Winner Takes Two: As the rounds progress, the game continues its natural selection process. The excitement amplifies as participants dwindle down to a thrilling finale with just two standing talk about a suspenseful showdown!

Game Notes:

- Inclusive Dynamics: Embrace the uneven distribution! If the chosen number matches perfectly with the
 total participants, such as the number three with nine participants, no worries. Just pick a different
 number next round.
- Multiple Rounds: Given its quick pace, the Mingle Icebreaker invites multiple rounds. This means non-stop enjoyment and ample chances for participants to interact in various configurations.
- Size It Up: In larger groups, opting for slightly larger numbers keeps the game flowing smoothly. But as
 the group size dwindles, consider switching to smaller numbers. This keeps the interactions lively and
 prevents anyone from feeling left out. Flexibility is the name of the game, ensuring that no matter the
 crowd, the Mingle Icebreaker fits like a glove.
